Nuclear Web: Electronic bulletin disseminating Internet's nuclear contents

RRIAN launched in August a monthly electronic bulletin for the dissemination of nuclear contents available on the Internet. This bulletin includes publications, new issues of electronic journals, upcoming congresses and sites of interest, contributing to the continuous updating of their users and widening the visibility of this material, which is mostly free, in Latin America. Sites of the main institutions in the nuclear field are monitored in a cooperative way to identify the new contents of nuclear interest.

At present, the bulletin is sent to almost 4,000 subscribers from the network participating countries.

the service of our Latin American Network, in my opinion, has nothing to envy that of IAEA headquarters, which is really good!!



It seems very good for me and it facilitates the access to publications not locally available.



The number of regional records sent to INIS database was almost the same of the previous year, presenting a slight reduction lower than 4%. The voluntary contributions, rather elevated in 2004, consisted of only 29 records in the last year, as no more requests were received from INIS.







Document exchange

The Regional cooperation for document exchange keeps contributing to widen the availability of nuclear information in Latin America, one of RRIAN's main objectives.

In 2005, the provision of documents among the network participating countries had an increase of 23% in relation to the previous year. In the first six months of 2006, the exchange kept a similar level.
